Sixth Form Enrolment Process

Dear Families,

I would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to you for encouraging your child to attend our recent Sixth Form Induction Day. It was a pleasure to welcome so many of our Year 11 students back into school as they begin to consider their next steps in education.

The day was a great success, and we were incredibly impressed by the maturity, enthusiasm, and engagement shown by all students. They approached the taster sessions with curiosity and confidence, and it was wonderful to see them exploring new subjects, meeting future teachers, and beginning to form the friendships and routines that will support them in Sixth Form.

We hope the experience gave your child a valuable insight into life in our Sixth Form and helped them feel excited and prepared for the journey ahead. Below you will find a reminder of the Sixth Form registration process and the option blocks for students to choose their subjects.

GCSE Results Day: Thursday 21st August

- Results will be available from the Sixth Form Centre [accessed via the rear of the school - across the metal bridge in the back car park] after 0830 on Thursday 21st August 2025.
- Please note that results cannot be given out over the telephone or via e-mail.
- If students wish to have results posted, a 1st class, stamped addressed envelope [marked GCSE Year 11 in the top left-hand corner] needs to be given to the Exams Office by no later than Monday 14th July 2025.
- If there are any exceptional circumstances where a pupil is unable to collect their results in person, and they have not provided a stamped addressed envelope in advance, please inform the school via the House emails as soon as possible.

Registration for Sixth Form Courses: Thursday 21st August & Friday 22nd August

- If you have met all of the entry requirements for your desired courses of study, you should register for the Sixth Form on results day [Thursday 21st August 2025]. This should be done using a **Google Form** that will be shared on the day via email. This form will also be available on the school website.
- Students should consult the Sixth Form Prospectus on the website to ensure that they have met the entry requirements and that their preferred subjects fit within our option blocks. Please note that all subject options are subject to change.



- If your child is unsure about which subjects to choose or misses out on meeting the entry requirements, they should make an appointment with the Sixth Form team. These meetings will take place on **Friday 22nd August 2025** in the Sixth Form Centre. Appointments can be arranged on results day.
- If your child is unable to attend then please contact Mrs Brown via the Sixth Form email address provided at the end of this letter.

Subject Choices

- The subject option blocks for students to make their choices are shown on the next page. Please note that these blocks are final and cannot be changed.
- When registering on Results Day, students may select only one subject from each of the four option blocks (1–4). Most students will choose three A Level subjects, which is the standard programme of study.
- In some cases, students may opt to take four A Levels. Please note that Further Mathematics must be taken as a fourth subject, not as part of a standard three-subject combination.
- If your child wishes to study Further Mathematics, they must select:
 - Further Mathematics from Option Block 1, and
 - Mathematics from Option Block 3
